# The Wave Sheaf Offering Day <br> 1ST DAY—NISAN 18 

## Sunday, April 9, AD 30 Nisan 18 9:00 AM First Day of the week

After the Sabbath - the Holy Day and the Weekly Sabbath - the Women Come to the Tomb Early. The Tomb Is Opened by Two Angels Who Tell the Women Jesus Is Not There. He Had Been Resurrected. The Disciples Come and Observe the Tomb, and Leave.
Jesus Reveals Himself to Mary Magdalene, and Tells Her Not to Touch Him Because He Has Not Ascended to the Father.

## The Feast of Firstfruits

Jesus Ascends to the Father, Is accepted as the first of the firstfruits and returns.
Lev 23:11 And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

## The Feast of Weeks

Lev 23:15-16 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete: (16) Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

Deu 16:9 Seven weeks shalt thou number unto thee: begin to number the seven weeks from such time as thou beginnest to put the sickle to the corn.

The barley harvest begins followed by the harvest of the wheat and other grains
This represents the harvest of the firstfruits into the kingdom of God
The count to Pentecost begins once the Wave Sheaf offering is complete.

The harvest of the firstfruits to God ends 9:00 AM on the day of Pentecost with the offering unto the Lord:

Lev 23:16-17 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD. (17) Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

## NOTE:

Pentecost is on a Sunday, a holy day (50th day, The Feast of Weeks). The day before is a Sab bath, a holy day. The last day of the harvest is a Friday, Day 48 of the count to Pentecost.

The Parable of the Ten Virgins Mat 25:1-13;
Mat 24:37-39 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. (38) For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, (39) And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Noah entered the ark 7 days before the rains came. Genesis 7:10
